## **Tools**

In a first stage, Homo Habilis has cut stones from various rocks. Then he has cut mainly flints in order to make two sided tools.

Neandertal Men had a variety of tools to suit every usage and made them out of flint, of bones, or out of antlers of reeindeer, New tools were invented such as scraper, graver, drill, or knife,

Where did they find the stones and the wood to make their weapons?

The first men would collect stones at the riverside or wood in the forests. During the reindeer- and mammoth age they would use the bones, the antlers or the tusks of their games. The last prehistoric men knew how to dig tunnels to look for flint mines.

How did they make stone tools?

Prehistoric men would hit several times a piece of flint with a piece of wood, a bone or another stone and thus obtain very sharp and pointed chips,

## The needle

15000 yers ago men have invented the needle, Reindeer gut or skin strips are used as yarn. From now on cloth can be well fitted ;men make bottles out of skin to carry water or cook food with a hot stone inside. Needles are made of bones.

## Right/Wrong

Prehistoric Men had iron knives, (W)

To clean a skin before making a cloth out of it they used a scraper R Homo Habilis could sew up clothes,(W)

Flint was the most used stone to make tools (R),

Some tools were made of tusks or bones (R),

Needles were made out of wood (W),

A harpoon is used to dig the soil (W)

A twosided tool is made of flint cut on both sides and is very sharp R
